The 2020 winner, Ms. Kenza Sallier, is a mathematical statistician working at Statistics Canada. Kenza's winning paper was ***'Toward More User-Centric Data Access Solutions: Producing Synthetic Data of High Analytical Value by Data Synthesis'***

Kenza received a cash prize of €1,500, a two-year IAOS membership, and a certificate acknowledging her success in the competition. In addition, the IAOS will fund registration fees, airfare, and hotel accommodation for Kenza to present her paper at an international conference once COVID-19 restrictions pass.
